Word of our Testimony

Tammy's Testimony

I've been using for about 45 years. I was molested at a young age. I was introduced to drugs and alcohol and started using both so I wouldn't have to deal with the hurt and the pain. As we both know, that doesn't really work. I've been through many programs. I even graduated a couple. I was missing something and you know what that was? God! I 've learned without God in my life, I have nothing and when you're walking with Him and keep Him first in your life, remember He will never leave you or forsake you! Now what has God done in my life? When I came to Set Free my eyes got so bad I was almost legally blind. Kerri (One of the leaders) decided I was going to be her project. Thanks to her and Set Free and the staff I was able to get laser surgery in both eyes. Now I have good eye sight. I had other medical issues also. I had a heart murmur. I went to a heart specialist. He took some tests and said I need a heart valve replaced. I was told I'd be in ICU for a couple of days, then in about four or five days and then sent home to recover. NOT! I was in ICU for about a week and in the hospital for a week or more. I was really weak, so they decided to send me to a recovery place. The next day I was back in the hospital with pneumonia. God had another plan for my life, and restoration. I hadn't seen my son for about three years. He came to see me in ICU and was able to bring my granddaughter who I've never seen. She's a little over a year old. This brought me even closer to my son. And you know, Its nothing I've done-its all by His grace. Whoever is still out there remember John 3:16" For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that each and everyone of us can have eternal life. I hope I can help. Just remember to

be still and know that He is God. Love You All.

Brian's Testimony

My name is Brian Tappe and this is my testimony. I'm 47 years old, 25+ of which I was an alcoholic/ drug addict. I lived a seemingly normal life, the youngest of four boys, parents still married. I have always known about God, but never really "knew" Him. I started acting out at a young age because I didn't feel like I fit in. I started smoking and experimenting with drugs and sneaking alcohol at age 13 and it was to look cool so I wouldn't get picked on. As I felt more "normal", like I fit in, it progressed. I was in a car accident when I was eighteen that should have killed me; rather than thanking God I took on the attitude that I was invincible. I started partying every day. I lived my life reckless and carefree. There were many times I should have been dead. I woke up on my thirtieth birthday and the first thought was that I was alive, now what? I started to try digging myself out of my muck and mire. In 2002 I met a woman I thought was going to be my wife and the mother of my children forever. We did get married and had two beautiful boys together, Sean-Ryan and Daniel Luke. Unfortunately, I was too new to being sober and responsible. I ended up in prison, after leaving them for drugs and alcohol. The shame, guilt, regret and depression overcame me. I did my first AA/NA program in 2011. It lasted for a few years. I held a job and got better jobs, leading me to North Dakota in 2013. Everything was going great. My brother Mike, who I looked up to and was my best friend came to work with me in September, 2013. The 7th of October, we crashed our truck on the way to work, jumping it sixty feet. We both had minor injuries. November 1st, He

was killed in another car accident. That was more than I could handle and I turned into a mean alcoholic. I hurt the ones I love, not knowing how to let go of the hurt I felt. On July 31st, 2015 I had a heart attack. I know God lifted me off the ground. At the same time of the heart attack, I had a blood clot in both of my lungs. Three months later I went and got a motel room and spent two months drinking and doing meth, U was at my end. Later in September 2016 I attempted suicide and survived it. At that point I knew God had a plan for me. I called Set Free and hit my knees begging God to fix me. It has been an amazing redemption process. All glory to God, I am getting restoration with family and am of service here at the ranch. I'm not going anywhere until He gives me direction. I know everything is possible through Christ who strengthens me!
