From then on it seemed I've had a better relationship with God, but I still have this addiction at the time I was bottling everything in. The truth was that I didn't have my all in Jesus. had me and wasn't going to give up because He didn't give up and my wife didn't give up neither on me I Give thanks to God and my wife for being there for me in the darkest of times God looked after me the whole time. I've learned so much I'm on fire for the Lord. He's been restoring me; He has healed me of all my pain. I'm 53 years old and I feel better now than I did when I was 30 years old. I was even playing flag football with the younger men at the ranch. I asked God to heal my body and he did and all you have to do is ask and it will be done. I can't stress how wonderful God is. The thing I pray for now is a good job so I can support my family. I'm starting a new chapter in my life and can't wait because of God. I'm not scared or worried, I'm excited my new adventure moving to Indiana. Right now, we are doing a outreach in Victorville feeding the homeless and praying for people it's so humbling being out there praying for others saving lives in Jesus name. Its hard for me to see many broken people and bring them to Christ but you must have faith. But if we can plant a mustard seed maybe it will grow.
