

I had a good upbringing, when I was little, we always went camping and fishing which I loved to do. I also played a lot of sports-Baseball, football! I use to love hunting with my father. He was a good man, until he would drink, all my family drank a bit. But my dad in those times was a drunk and he would beat my mother in front of us and I would get afraid and cry my sisters and my brothers would get really hurt as well. I was young and afraid for my mother, we would end up walking the streets at night, it was at this time about 7 years old and loved my mom a lot she was a very loving person and a very beautiful woman. I was little but wanted to protect her so I would carry a knife because men were always cat calling, now seeing those beatings did something to me and I grew up fast and I wanted to hurt my dad for what he did to us, and I grew up confused about a lot of things so most of my time I was alone hanging around with bad kids and picking up bad habits from my parents

and family members and parents friends. When I was 9 an older girl slept with me. then came the drinking and the drugs, the stealing, and the lying. I started sniffing paint and smoking weed. these things I learned from older kids and my parents were too busy to notice, so I got worse and worse, anything to alter my thinking, my feelings and I became a lost little kid, and that little boy was in a gang of rushing roulette for the rest of his life, but between these dark times, I would always find time to go to church, even though it was for the wrong reasons, I knew of God but I never applied the word, so I got deeper involved in a dark tunnel. my life went out of control but I believe God loves us all and we all make mistakes and in those dark times we need to have faith.
