When I attended God's Ranch, November 3rd of 2021, I came in here broken, lost, confused and depressed. I came here not knowing where I was going or where I will end up, also not caring about anything. I had buried my little brother before coming here and that took a toll on me. I have taken things for granted and my relationship with my little brother was one of them. My heart was heavy and so was the burden. I wasn't strong enough to handle it so when I got to God's Ranch, I started to get in the Word, know the Word and Word. I knew who God was, but I didn't really have a relationship with Him. But when I got into the Word, I started to have a relationship with God. I came here a dead man walking meaning my spirit was dead. But in due time God brought me back to life. The more I read the Word of God, I got stronger. The more I sought God, He started speaking to me. Our Heavenly Father is and awesome God. By the time I was done with my commitment here, God has set me free from my depression. He has healed me and found me as well. Like the song says I was once lost but now I'm found. I thank God for showing me love, mercy and grace when I didn't deserve it. I wouldn't have made it through my depression all alone. God got me through the storm. Testimony—Casey Baker

I started using drugs when I was about 9yrs old as far as alcohol and drugs or weed. Then as I got older my neighbors growing up cooked and sold meth and at thirteen years old I started using speed after being released from juvenile hall for smoking marijuana at school. I ended up going back eight more times and into a group home from when I was sixteen until I was eighteen years old. Before that I was kicked out of Colton High School for doing hallucinogens at school. Well hells bells I had a rough childhood because my parents divorced at a get a better understanding of the young age and I suffered a lot of abuse as a kid. As an adult I ended up in prison countless times and a lot of homelessness and a lot of men's homes. A lot of times I didn't do well with authority so I would not make it long in sobriety, but I really hit my bottom this last time as I lost my four babies mothers and the rights to my children. I lost my job as an electrician. I lost a place to stay with my wife and mother and became homeless after release from jail and humbled myself after a few years. My mother and sister found this place, where I have learned a lot more about Jesus and have dealt with some of my hurts, habits and hangups. I hope to learn how to be a better member of society and hopefully make it to a second-phase home and get a job and try to become a better member of society and a better Christian. I also hope to get my children back in my life and for God to restore my relationship with my mom and sister and family. Amen. Casey Baker

So my journey started with my wife leaving me after fifteen years. Then from there the alcohol took over which led to drugs-drugs I was on for about a year. And what a wild ride it was. Going from having anything to being on the street was a very rough thing. I sold all of my stuff to support my addictions. Then falling in love again I was completely broken. Then I felt like my life was starting to get better. Then I started hanging around with the wrong people and then the roller coaster started up again. I went through two houses and ended up getting thrown out into the streets still drinking and doing drugs and then finally I went to jail. I thought that would have been enough to scare me clean. I also overdosed on meth before I went to jail, which my girl revived me. So I got out of jail and was doing good for about a week. Then I started messing with fentanyl and ended up in some drug den in Barstow where I had died from fentanyl which I had to be revived again. My sister ended up coming to get me. I detoxed at her house and my uncle and my ex-wife were talking, saying I needed to come here to be humbled and find Jesus. So here I am now feeling great and praising Jesus for saving my life when he did. I feel like this program is working really good for me. The staff and brothers are awesome and have been helping me through my rough patches. I feel closer to God now than I have ever felt in my life and I enjoy every time we get to here about the Lord. -Brent Aston
